Getting Started

Overview files

Start by downloading from our products section - vtem.net - the VTEM Slides module package.

After downloading the package, be sure to unpack locally the `vtem_slides_pack.zip` file. If all goes well, you should see the following files:

Here's an overview of the available files:

Module:

`mod_vtem_slides.zip`

This is the module file to be installed on your Joomla application. It will display all the content set on the selected website pages.

doc!!! - folder:

`HelpFile.pdf`

This help file that will help you to install, set and configurations your VTEM Slides module.

Source - folder:

`PhotoShop source files`

The source in psd. format file for Photoshop Graphic Editor, that you can use for customization of arrow design.

VTEM Slides Module Installation

The installation is very simple and should not pose any problem, if you follow the next instructions in properly way.

Using the Joomla! 1.5 Administrator, navigate to the administrative panel on your site and from your administration top menu, select **Extensions > Install/Uninstall**.

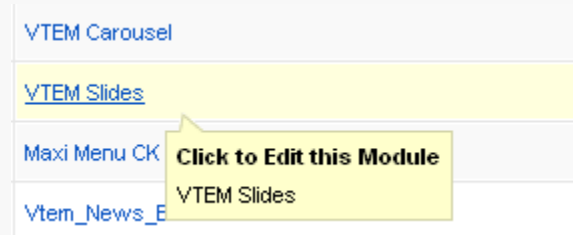
Click the 'browse' button, select the module file (`mod_vtem_slides.zip`) and press 'Upload File & Install.'

A message will appear saying 'Module Installation - Success.'

The VTEM Slides module is now available on your Modules Manager.

Module Configuration

VTEM Slides Configuration



To configurations your VTEM Slides module, navigate to “Extensions > Module Manager” and find the VTEM Slides module on the available list.

Click on it to enter inside and to edit the module parameters configuration.

From left to right, set the module in your selected position and enable it.

Before saving the module, you must configurations the following parameters fields:

Module parameters:

Module Class Suffix:

A suffix can be applied from the CSS class of the module and this will allow individual module CSS style.

Module unique ID:

Each module must have unique ID, if you have two or more modules working (i.e. Slideshow1 or Slideshow2).

Module height:

Use to display height of the module in pixels. You must set this value as bigger than 0. (i.e. 250)

Module width:

Use to display width of the module in pixels. You must set this value as bigger than 0. (i.e. 780)

Background:

Set background color as hex value (i.e. #F5F5F5)

► Advanced Parameters

Text color:

Set color as hex value for text interface div (i.e. #000000)

Active navigation color:

Set active navigation color as hex value (i.e. #FFFFFF)

Border color:

Set border color as hex value (i.e. #FFFFFF)

Module rounded:

Select "YES" or "NO" to set Rounded/Not rounded for the module

Style of layouts:

Select style of layouts (if you need to change style of layouts you must replace one of available sets).

- Layout style1
- Layout style2
- Layout style3
- Layout style4
- Layout style5

Animation effects type:

Select type of module animation: fade, scrollUp, shuffle ...

Animation speed:

Set how long will be animation transition In milliseconds.

Animation timeout:

Set how long will be slide visible after animation in milliseconds.

Enable pause mode:

YES to pause when hovering over

Prev/Next and Pause/Resume buttons:

Set YES to show the buttons.

Section:

Select section which will be source of articles.

Category:

Select category which will be source of articles.

Sections:

Select objectively sections which will be source of articles -IDs of sections separated by comma (i.e. 1,2,3,4,5).

Categories:

Select objectively categories which will be source of articles- IDs of categories separated by comma (i.e. 1,2,3,4,5).

Article IDs:

Select IDs of articles which will be source of content - IDs of articles separated by comma (i.e. 1,2,3,4,5).

No. of items:

Set max. amount of news which will be visible in module.

News order:

Select value which will be base of sort. Options: Recently Added First, Recently Modified First, Article ordering or Random.

Show title:

If you want to show title of article.

Linked titles:

If you want to enable links to articles.

Show Readmore:

If you want to show readmore button of article.

Image position:

Select Left/Right to show image position on the module

Images resize:

Set YES to resize images on the module

Only Frontpage:

If you want to show frontpage articles from content component

Limit type:

Select limit type in words or chars.

Max amount:

Set intro-text length in words or chars (i.e: 500)

Clean (X)HTML in content:

Clean HTML tag in content of the module.

Jquery load:

Use this option only if you have a problem with scripts on your site. In other situations option YES is strongly recommended. If you want to run more than one copy of this

module on same page then set this value for disabled. Also if you have an jquery framework included on your site, then disable this option also.

CSS:

Use to add your css.

Customizable CSS Classes

CSS Classes for advanced customization

If you have some knowledge of how to set up style sheets, here are the main classes that you can format to create your own design.
