

Lazer WordPress Theme

Installing Theme

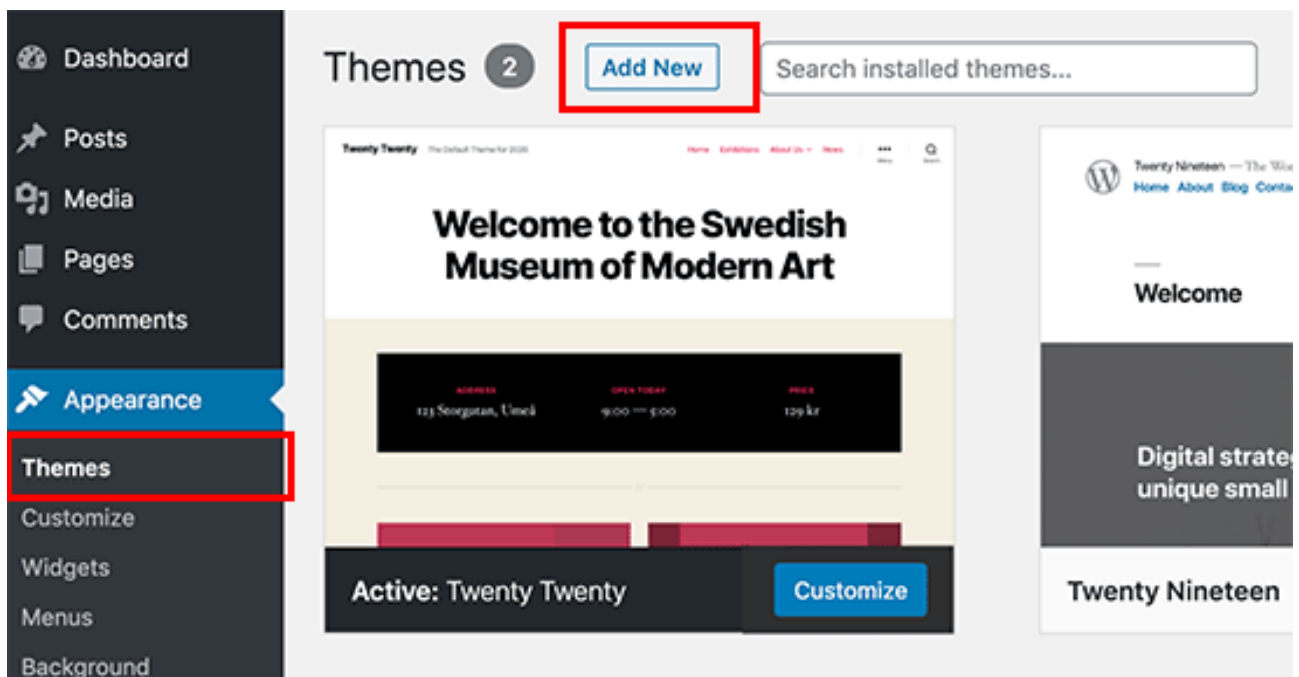
To install the theme you'll need to unzip the folder you downloaded from ThemeForest. It'll have a .zip file inside, this file is your theme. In this case, it's the file: **lazer.zip**.

To install it, open your Dashboard and go to Appearance → Themes and click in the Add New button.

In the following page, click in Upload Theme button and select the .zip file that contains your theme.

Click in Install Now. Remember your upload file size limit should be something between 8MB - 16MB, else will be necessary install it using FTP.

After the installation is complete, click in the button Activate to finally activate your theme and be ready to work with it!



Installing Plugins

After installing the theme, you'll see a notice in your Dashboard asking you to install and activate a few plugins. A few plugins are required and other recommend to work with our theme.

Click in Begin installing plugins to start the process. You'll see a list of plugins available to installation.

You'll see that plugins are marked as Required and should be installed by you in order to fully use the theme. The other plugins aren't required and if you won't use them you shouldn't select and install them. But if you don't install these plugins, a few features will be missing.

Select the plugins to install, select Install in the "Bulk Actions" select and click in Apply.

A few plugins must be downloaded from our private servers, so it can take a while to finish, wait patiently!

After finish the installation you must activate the plugins to start using it. Select the plugins again, go to "Bulk Actions" and select Activate, click in Apply.

The plugins will be activated and ready to use.

Bundled premium plugins may ask for a purchase code for registration/activation once installed. You can simply ignore these messages as bundled plugins do not require activation or registration. The plugin will still work as intended with the theme once the theme has been activated/registered.

Import Demo Content

This step is optional, you'll learn how to import the whole dummy content from our demo to be able to customize it. If you want to create your own content and don't import anything just jump to the next section.

Our theme comes with a one-click demo importer module. To import one of our demo sites, please follow these steps:

1. Open your Dashboard.

2. Go into **Appearance** → **Import Demo Data**.

3. Click on the "**Import Demo Data**" button and wait for the import process to finish. Wait few minutes.

Also you can use standard WordPress Importer.

Importing Theme Options Sample Data

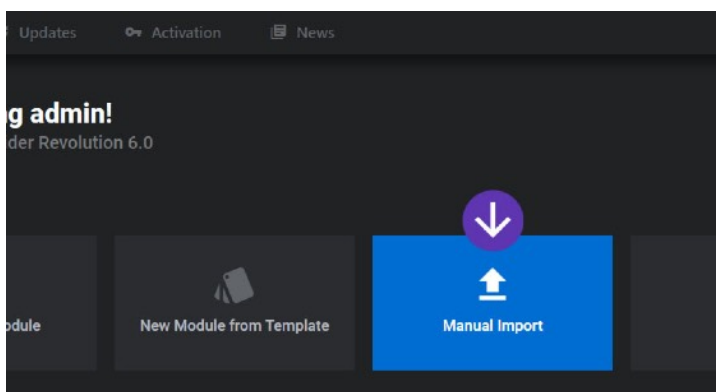
Go to Dashboard → Theme Options → Import/Export and import data from theme-options.json (Demo Content folder).

Importing Demo Content

This theme comes with our demo content (xml files in Demo Content folder) which can be imported directly on your website to achieve the same look as our demo. To import the our content go to your WordPress admin page dashboard, and select Dashboard → Tools → Import and then choose WordPress option.

Import Sliders (Slider Revolution)

Go to Dashboard → Slider Revolution. From the plugin's main admin page, select "Manual Import"



Next, select "Click to Choose" and select the template zip included with your theme's download files (**Demo Content / Sliders**).

Creating a menu

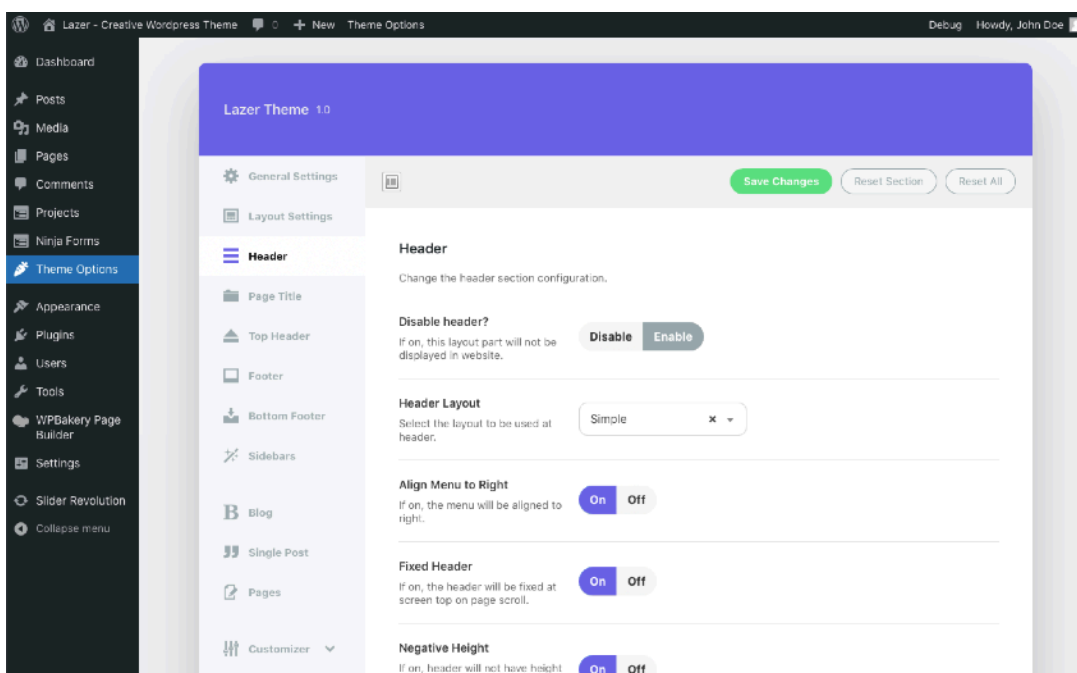
To create a menu for your site, do the following:

- From the dashboard go to Appearance → Menus;
- On the left, find the list section that starts with Pages;
- Check the checkbox of every element you want to have in your menu;
- Click on Add to Menu;
- Finally, you have to set Display location in Menu Settings as Primary and click on **Save Menu** button.

Theme Options

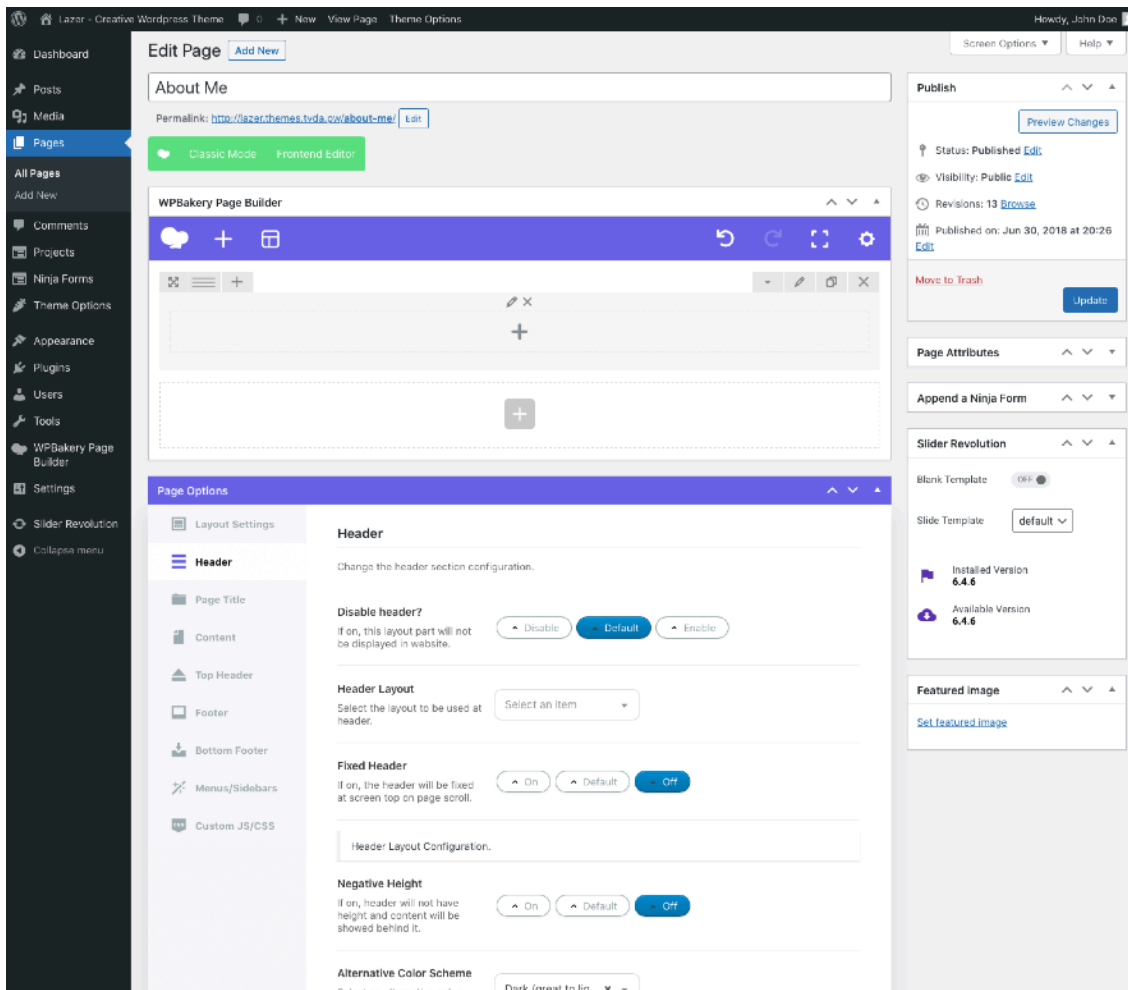
Theme Options panel is built with the renowned Redux Framework and gives you many configuration options in a user-friendly environment. Click the Theme Options tab from the main WordPress navigation and then you will be able to access and enjoy many core features of theme. All the options have detailed descriptions in order to explain their purpose.

Go to Customizer tab to change **Typography Options, Colors, Backgrounds and etc.**



Page Options


Just below the Page Editor you will notice meta box (section for settings): Page Options. Here you can set everything you need apart from the content of the pages (you will use the awesome Page Builder for this). With these options, you can override any options you have set in Theme Options. This means that you can handle individually each one of your pages/projects/posts.



Assigning Home Page

If you're new to WordPress you might be wondering why even after importing a demo your website home page is still displaying your blog posts. This is because by default WordPress shows your blog as the home, to change that head over to the **Settings** → **Reading** section in your WordPress Admin dashboard.

On this page select A Static Page option for Front Page Displays. You'll then see dropdown selects for both the Front Page and the Posts Page. Select your desired pages for each – the one selected for the front page will display as your website home page.

Updating Theme

Step 1. Download the theme archive from ThemeForest.

Step 2. Head over to **Appearance** → **Themes** in your WordPress dashboard.

Step 3. Click the Add New button on the top of the page followed by Upload Theme.

Step 4. Locate the .zip file you extracted from the ThemeForest download archive and click the Install Now button.

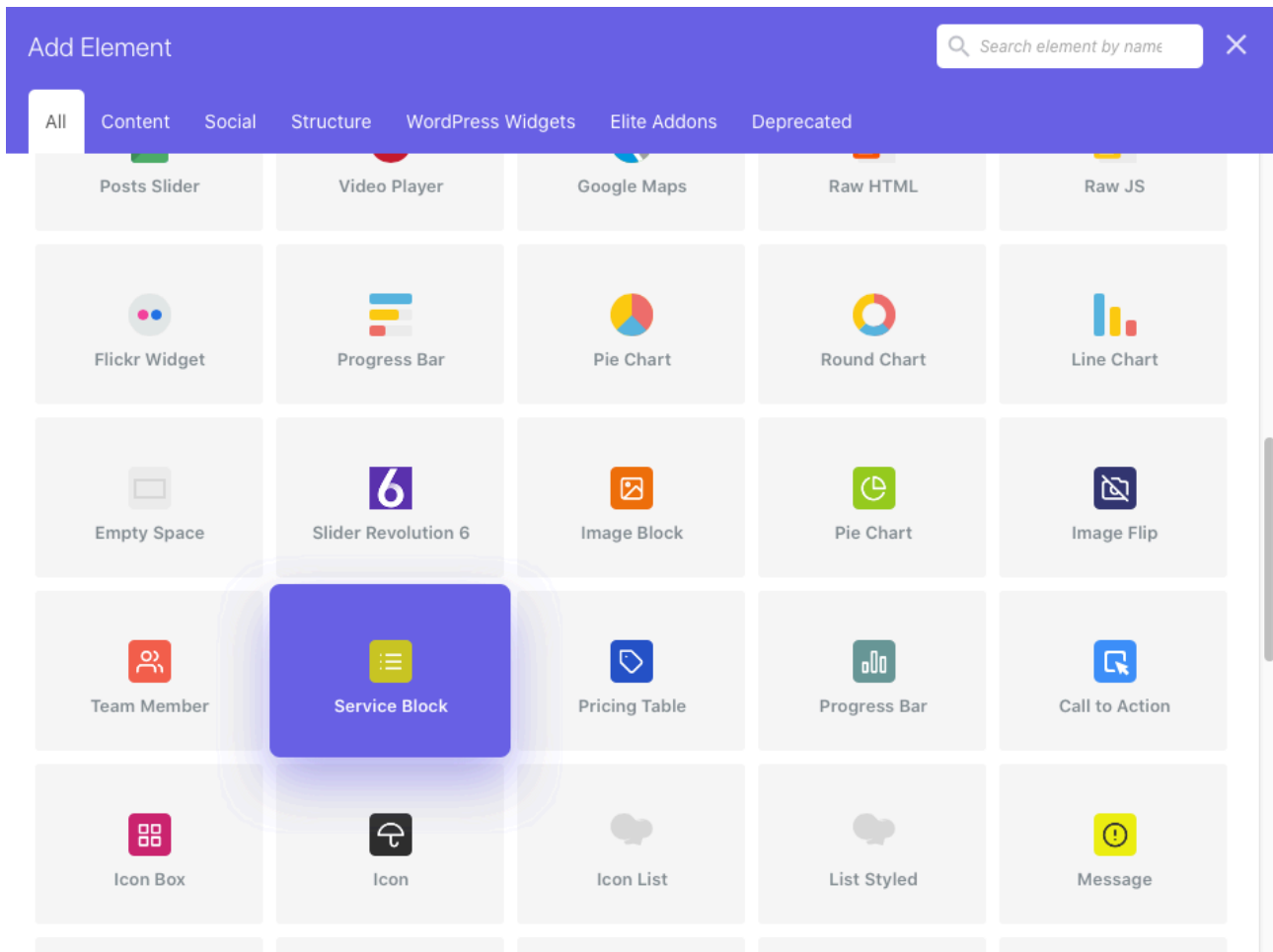
Step 5. Select “Replace Current with Uploaded” as shown below.

After update the theme, you'll see a notice in your Dashboard asking you to install or update a few plugins.

Page Builder

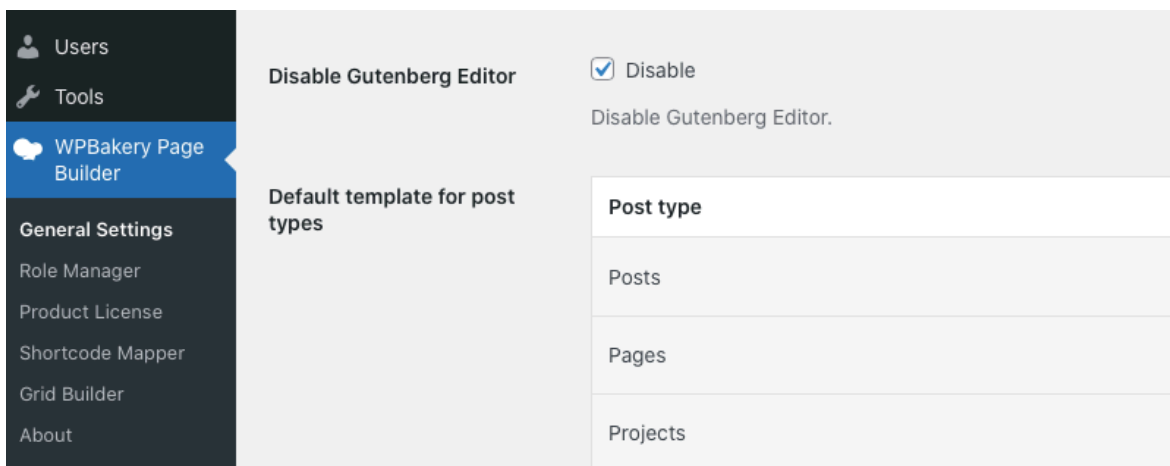
Lazer utilizes an enhanced version of the popular WPBakery Page Builder, for Frontend or Backend page creation.

How to Disable Gutenberg

Go to **Dashboard** → **WPBakery Page Builder** → **General Settings** and select option 'Disable Gutenberg Editor'.



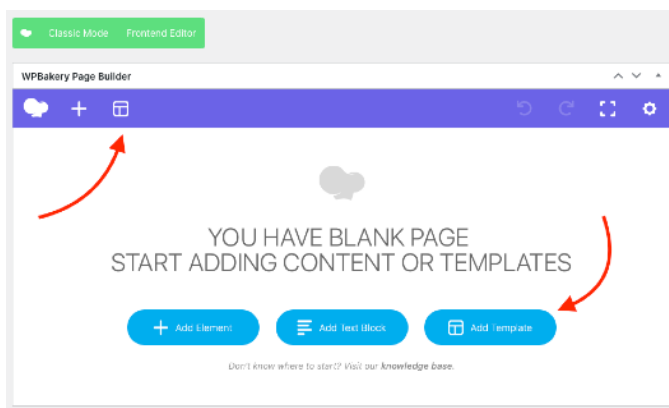
Default Templates

Step 1. Create or Edit page.

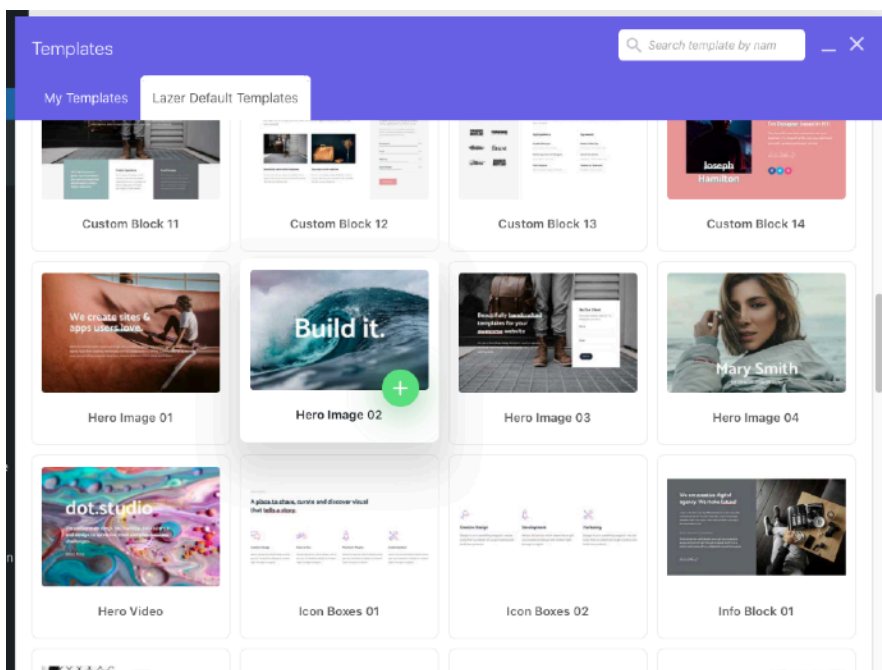
Step 2. Open Backend or Frontend editor.
