

# Installation

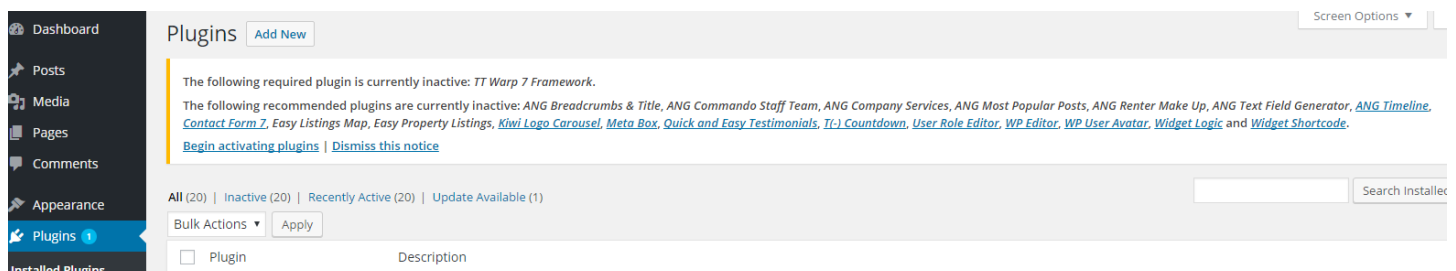
Setting up a Warp theme follows the standard WordPress installation procedure and works like with any other theme. In order to download the current version, please visit [wordpress.org](http://wordpress.org/) (<http://wordpress.org/>). Please check WordPress Codex ([http://codex.wordpress.org/Installing\\_WordPress](http://codex.wordpress.org/Installing_WordPress)) for information on how to install WordPress on your server.

Once WordPress is successfully installed, you will have to upload the theme to your WordPress directory. Download and un-zip the *meda-package* folder. You will find 4 folders and one of them 01\_Theme. There are two zipped theme folders *01\_meda\_v1.0.0.zip* and *02\_meda-Child-Theme.zip*. If you want to use a child theme, will have to install two themes.

Open your WordPress dashboard. Go to Appearance > Themes. Click the **Add New Theme** button, then **Upload Theme** and select the 01\_meda\_v1.0.0.zip file. Click Install Now.

## Installing recommended plugins

Once activated Meda will be display a notification to install and activation the required plugins.

## Setup a demo package

If you are new to wordpress or have problems creating posts or pages that look like the Theme Demo you can import dummy posts and pages here that will definitely help to understand how those tasks are done.

Importing demo data (post, pages, images, theme settings, ...) is the easiest way to setup your theme. It will allow you to quickly edit everything instead of creating content from scratch. When you import the data following things will happen:

- All existing posts, pages, categories, images, custom post types or any other data may be deleted or modified.
- Some WordPress settings will be modified.
- Posts, pages, some images, some widgets and menus will get imported.
- Images will be downloaded from our server, these images are copyrighted and are for demo use only .
- Please click import only once and wait, it can take a couple of minutes

Before you begin, make sure all the required plugins are activated.

Go to Meda->Quick Demo-> Demo Data and click on the picture. The Install of demo data should take a few minutes, after you will receive a notification "Import completed successfully"

# Setting

The general theme section allows you to control the behaviour and the overall appearance of your theme.

To configure this part go to Meda->Settings.

## Styles

The style section contains the customizer.

Click **Customizer** to create your own style for the whole site or individual pages. You can pick colors, modify sizes and much more with a real time theme preview. Choose the style to be loaded in the layout options.

Click **Copy** and enter a new name to duplicate the style. Then you choose your new style from the list and can make adjustments.

To get more capabilities use "Advanced Model". After all the changes, click Save.

## Development

Always uncheck following options for your production website.

- ☒ Compile LESS in the browser on every page load.
- ☒ Allow styles to be loaded by URL. This will override the style originally loaded by the theme.

Compile LESS

**Note** Compiling LESS will replace all related CSS files. All styles will be compiled at once.

Setting	Description
Compile LESS in the browser on every page load	Check the first option and the browser automatically compiles your LESS files via JavaScript every time you load a page. This provides an appropriate testing environment. I It's not recommended to enable developer mode on the live site as the constant process of compiling is highly inefficient.
Allow styles to be loaded by URL. This will override the style originally loaded by the theme.	The option enables the browser to load styles by URL. This is useful, if you want to test different styles for your website. Disable this option, when your website goes live.

To finish your LESS modifications, hit the **Compile LESS** button and all your changes will be compiled into the final CSS.

Make sure, you aren't developing in the /styles/STYLE-NAME/css folders, because these folders will be overridden as soon as you hit the **Compile LESS** button.

## Compression

To optimize page load time, choose one of the following compression options.

Minify CSS and JavaScript into a single file. Use gzip compression and Data URIs to reduce image file requests.

Setting	Description
None	All files will be loaded separately and fully sized.
Combination + Minify	This option will minimize and combine CSS and JavaScript files into one single file.
Combination + Minify + Data URIs	Data URI embeds image data directly into the document, thus reducing the HTTP requests for your image files. This applies only to images that have a maximum size of 10kB.
Combination + Minify + Data URIs + Gzip	Gzip allows a faster data transfer through compressed data packages, instead of dealing with large data volumes by sending them separately

## Responsive

The viewport meta tag controls the layout on mobile browsers. If it's not set, the default width on mobile is 980px and the site will look the same like on desktops.

Subtitle	Adds subtitle under the main titile.

## Dropdown menu

The options in Meda->Menus help you easily distribute sub menu of any item to the desired number of columns for convenient use. To do this, just select the menu-> item of menu and specify the number of **Columns**.

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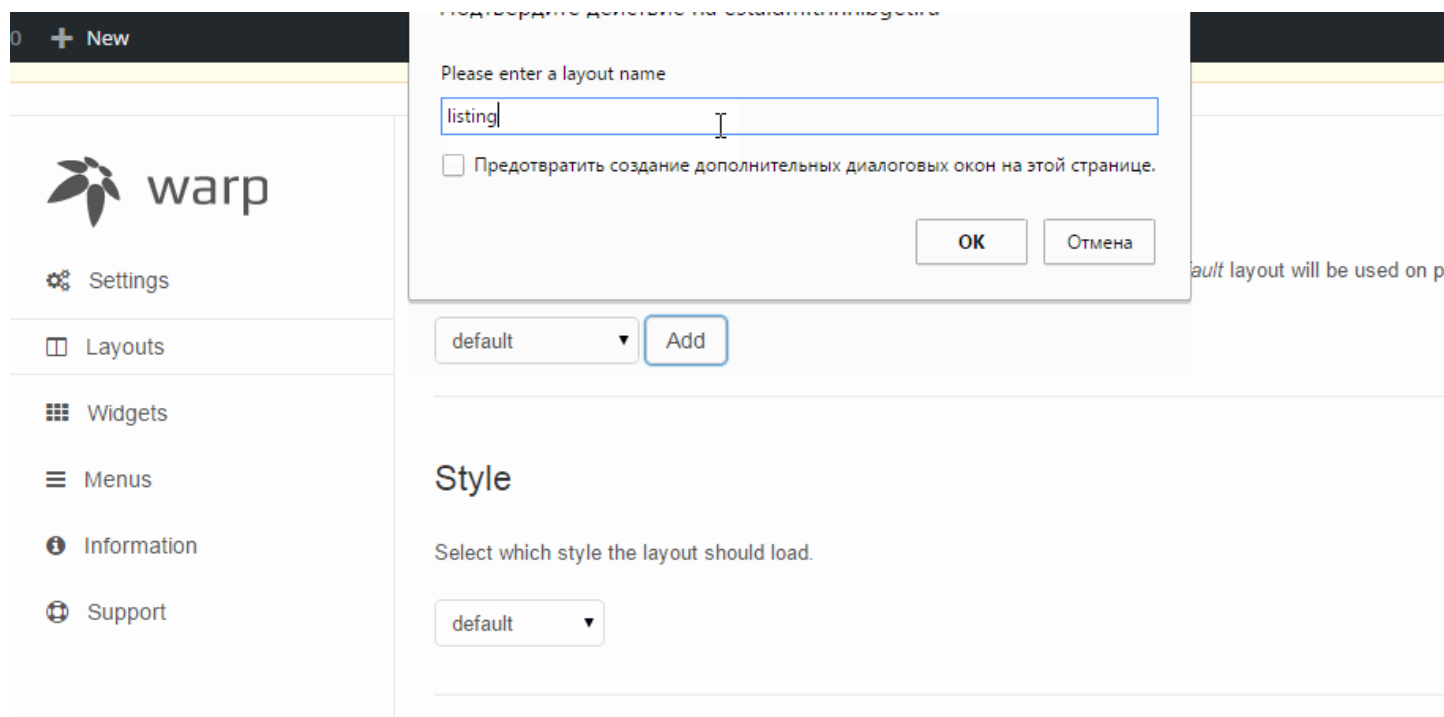
# Layouts

This section makes the arrangement of your content very easy and flexible. You can enable or disable system output, define the layout of the theme's widget or module positions and select a style you created in the customizer. Additionally you have the possibility to store your modifications in a layout profile and assign it to different pages.

Click **Add** in Layouts page and enter a new name to create the layout.

“Style” option enables you to assign a style to your layout. In addition with the customizer and the layout manager this makes styling your pages very flexible.

Fullscreen	Allows to install all the elements of the position of the fullscreen
Divider	Add a vertical divider between parallel or first doubled widgets/modules to separate them from each other.

# Child theme

Unless you are absolutely sure that you will never ever need to modify any of the theme files you should install and activate a child theme for Meda.

For your convenience Meda comes with a ready to use child theme. You'll find the "meda child" in Appearance->Theme if you have already installed it or install meda-child-theme.zip file. Its files structure is as in the image below.
