

## Step 1 :


Open the “Fast and Dynamic Slideshow” After Effects Project, Which works in Adobe After Effects CC 2019 and above



Import all required Photos/Videos by double clicking in the Project window

You can use 18 Videos/Photos

## Step 2 :




Drag the imported Photo and drop it in timeline

Open Video Placeholder comp,  
Delete the Default Image and place  
your Photo

**Replace the Photos in "Video Placeholder 01 to 18"**  
**By Default Video Placeholders are Full HD, 1920x1080 Pixels**  
**Make sure your Photos fits inside the composition**  
**Make sure you have replaced all required Photos before proceeding to the next step**

### Step 3 :

After Replacing all 18 Photos, Goto “Window” Menu and enable “Essential Graphics Panel”




