For having Generators Transitions in Final Cut Pro:

1 If you have Apple Motion installed on your Mac, copy Generators Transitions Folder to: /Movies/Motion Templates/Generators.


2 If you do not have Apple Motion installed on your Mac, copy Generators Transitions Folder to: Applications/Final Cut Pro/Contents/Plugins/MediaProviders/MotionEffects.fcp/Contents/Resources/Templates/Generators

Relaunch the Final Cut Pro to see the Effects.


The folder with Generators Transitions will appear in the generators library.

To add and use items for transitions, drag and drop it from Generators library to timeline and place on top of the layer to which the transition will be applied.


Select the transition layer and and go to the video inspector panel. Change Blend Mode to the Stencil Alpha.




Select the transition layer and the layer with your video, right-click and select “New Compound Clip”



Now the transition layer is used as a mask for your video.



You can make the transitions more attractive, add a few more transitions between layers with your video. Then select the transition layer and go to the Generator Inspector panel to adjust Published Parameters. You can change the color, add glow and pixellate effects.



Also you can use this items as transitions to color solid background.
