For having Titles in Final Cut Pro:

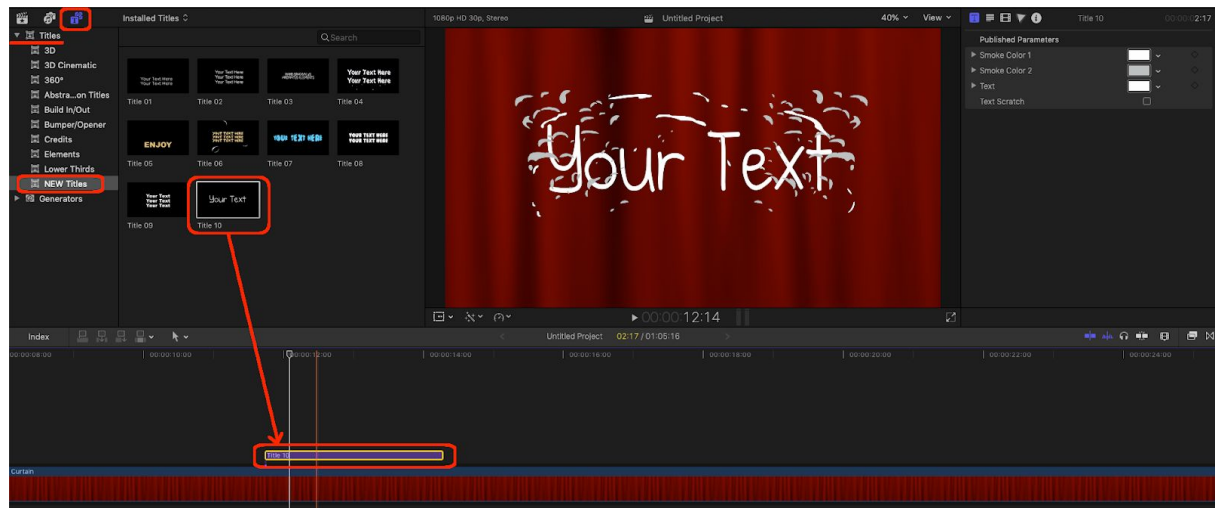
1 If you have Apple Motion installed on your Mac, copy Titles Folder to: /Movies/Motion Templates/Titles.

2 If you do not have Apple Motion installed on your Mac, copy Titles Folder to: Applications/Final Cut Pro/Contents/Plugins/MediaProviders/MotionEffects.fcp/Contents/Resources/Templates/Titles.

Relaunch the Final Cut Pro to see the Effects.

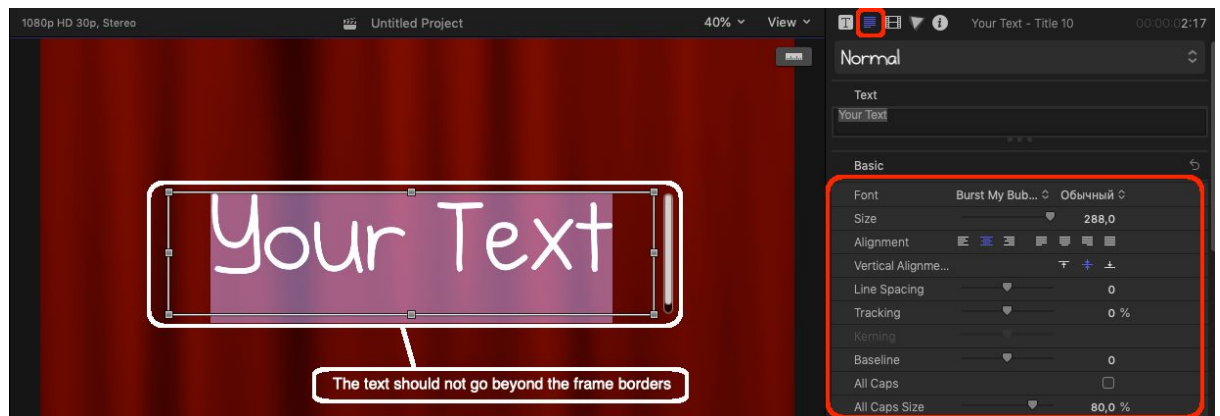
The folder with Titles will appear in the titles library.

1. To add and edit items drag and drop it from Titles library to timeline.

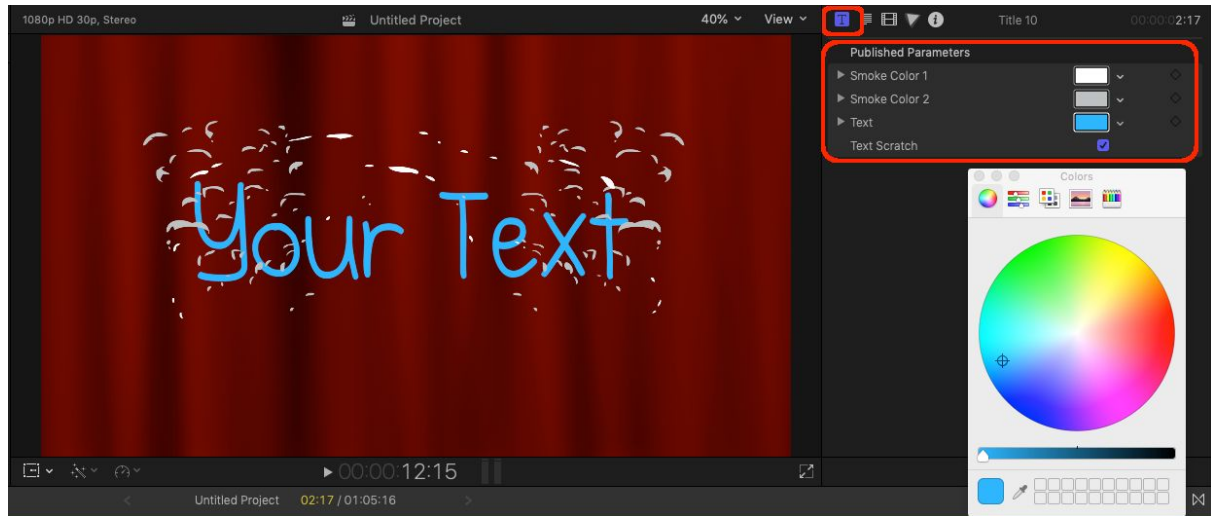


2. Double click on the text to edit it. Go to the "Text Inspector" panel to adjust your text. You can change font, size and other attributes.

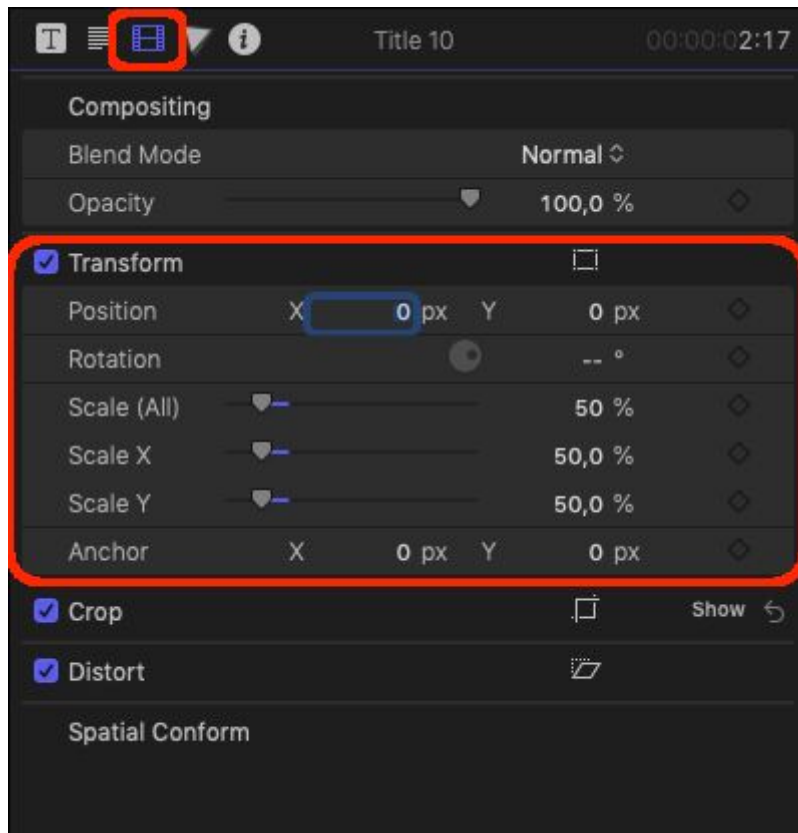
The text should not go beyond the frame borders



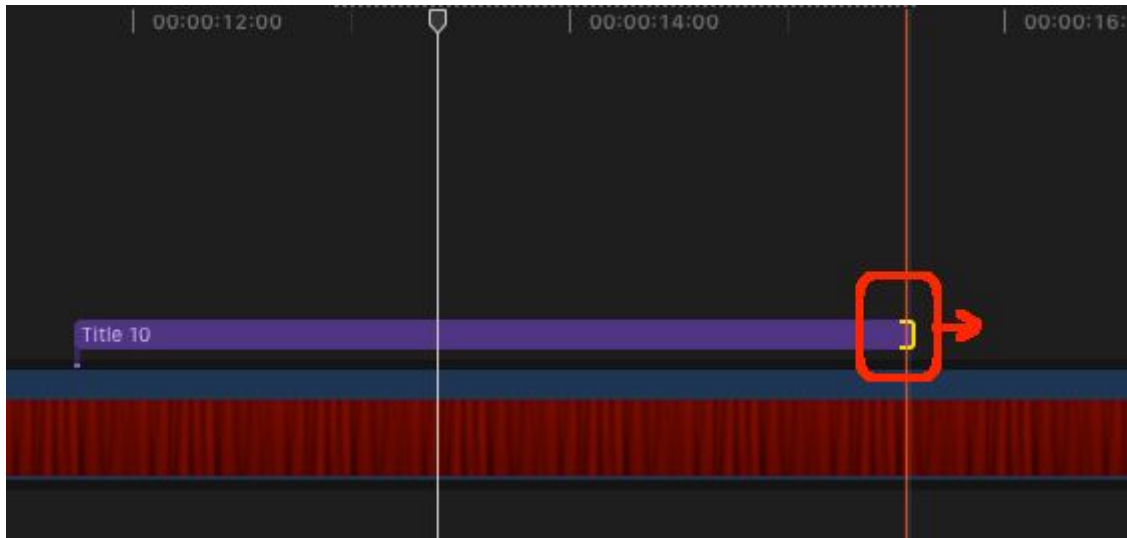
3. Go to the “Title Inspector” and adjust Published Parameters. Change the text and elements colors. Switch on/off “Text Scratch” option (if applicable)



4. Go to the “Video Inspector” panel for edit position, scale and rotation of the title.



5. You can change the length of the title without changing the intro and outro animation, just drag and stretch the title layer in the timeline.
