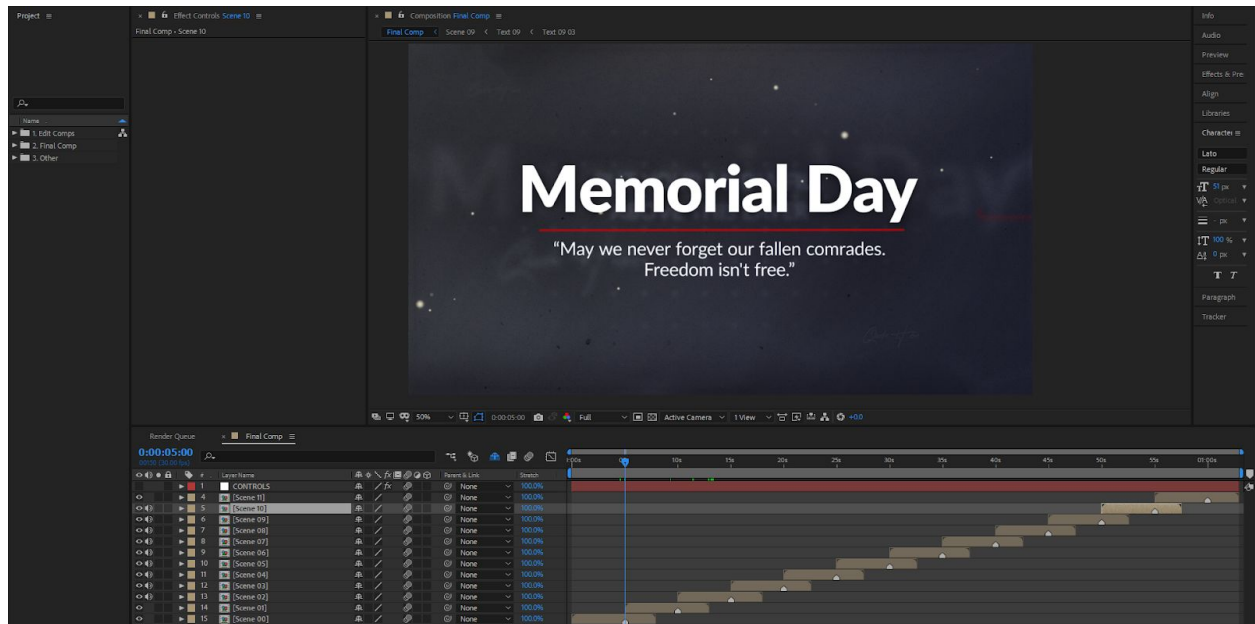

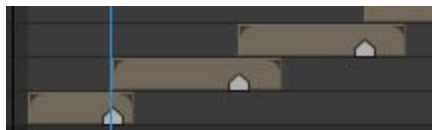

How to use it:

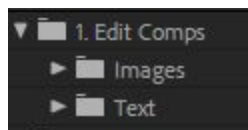
In the opened project you will see Final Comp. This is the main compositions, where you can move scenes or remove them:



Please note that a composition need some time to transition, because of that, scenes should overlap like on the pic below:

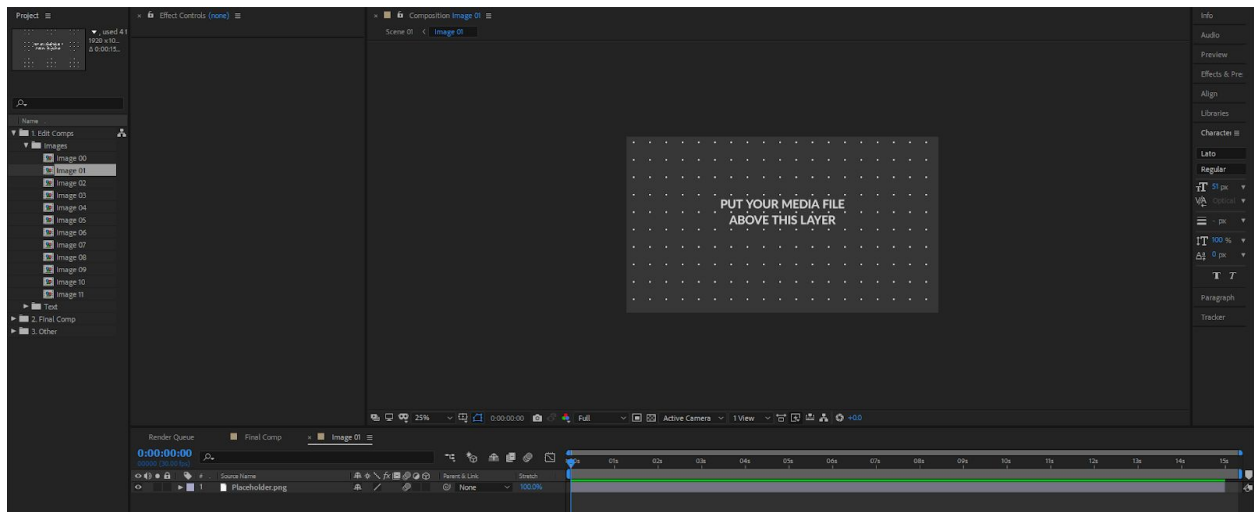


There are **Edit Comps** folder, this is where you should put media files, logo and change text.

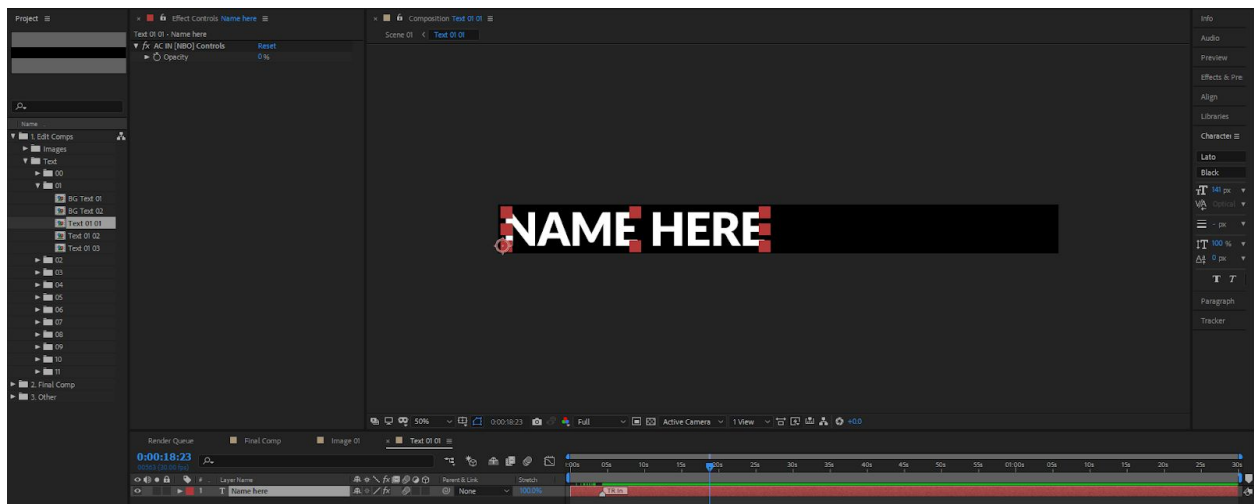


Let's put some Photos. For example, we will add images to Scene 01.

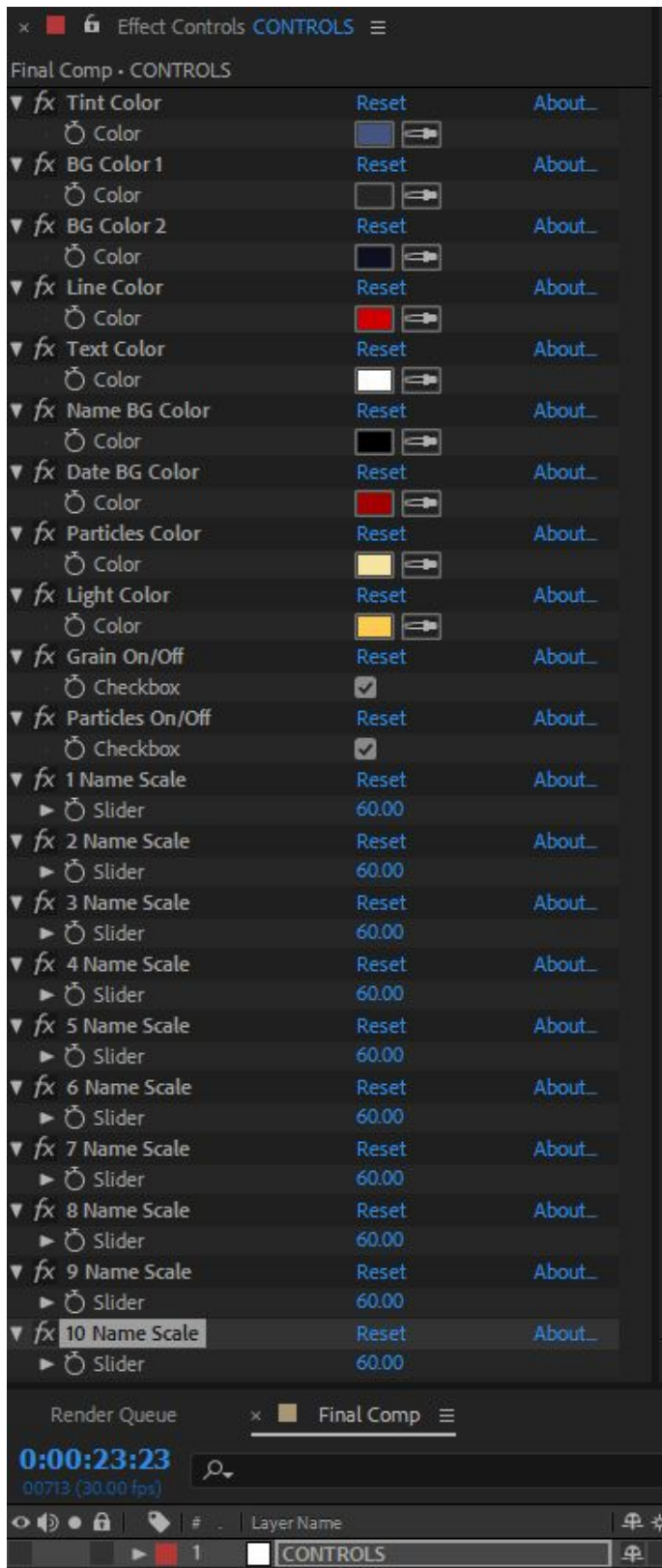
So, open **Images - Image 01**. Just drag and drop your photo here above the placeholder file.



Change text in Text folder. There are two background text placeholders for quotes, **Text 01** - placeholder for name or title, **Text 02** - for date or subtitle, **Text 03** - for description. Open **Text - 01 - Text 01 01**, double click on the text layer and type your text.



There is a **CONTROLS** layer In **Final Comp** composition, which controls colors, effects and name background scale. Select **CONTROLS** layer and change colors in Effect Controls.



Once done with all parts, open **Final Comp** composition and hit render.
